

- Establish robust Integrated Program Offices (IPO) responsible for project execution with clear command and control by the assigned District Commander
- Supplement Government Staff with Contractor Capability
- Leverage USACE Regional and National Capability = Leadership as well as technical/managerial
- Apply MILCON Transformation concepts to Acquisition, Process, and Organizational Structure
- Remain postured to support emerging Joint Engineer Initiative in coordination with OSD and USACE intent




Regional Transformation Fort Belvoir Command and Control



BRAC05, FY 07, Integrated Design-Bid-Build

- **Scope:** \$1.4 B for NGA relocation and consolidation into 2.4 M square foot office building. Includes SCIF, data center, 10 MW power plant and remote delivery facility.
- Status: Project is fast tracked, contractor on board and integrating design and construction, continued coordination for permits and design integration/reviews.
 - Sitework ongoing including security fence, trailers, erosion control measures
 - 35% design package of main building under review

BRAC05, FY 08, Design-Build

- **Scope:** \$1.1B for relocation and consolidation of over 6,200 personnel into single 2.2M square foot campus.
- Status: Project pending site selection.
 - Task order issued to study GSA site as EPG alternative work ongoing.
 - Studying proposals from Request for Expressions of Interest (REFI) with development options for alternate private sites.
 - Planning 2-step evaluation of proposals.

- Jun 08 Execute site acquisition (GSA/private)





- **Scope:** \$ 747M for 1.1M square foot hospital complex with central energy plant, helipad, and 2600 vehicle parking garage.
- **Status:** Project is fast tracked, contractor on board and integrating design and construction, continued coordination for permits and design integration/reviews.

 - Overall 20% design

Fairfax County Parkway



Federal Funding, FY 08 (est), Design-Bid-Build

- **Scope:** Federal Highways Administration (FHWA) project to build \$114M Fairfax County Parkway (FFCP) connecting I-95 to Franconia-Springfield Parkway.
- Status: Coordinating project execution MOA between VDOT, USA, and FHWA.
 - CWE currently \$174M; all parties working to close funding and/or scope gap
 - Design on track to meet NGA deployment requirements

Private Funding, FY10, Design-Bid-Build

- Scope: \$170M for 128K SF world class museum to serve as the capstone of the Army Museum System. Includes main museum, parade ground, amphitheater, memorial garden and parking. \$36M for exhibits will be procured under a separate contract.
- **Status:** Museum A-E procurement underway. Conducting site feasibility study (FS) to determine site. Working on scoping and funding issues.






Infrastructure



BRAC05, FY 08-10, Design-Bid-Build



- Scope: \$152M for roads, bridges, utilities, and other infrastructure to support FBVA BRAC projects (EPG/main post).
- Status: Design phase for \$20 M in FY08 projects.
 - Implementing essential early infrastructure projects
 - Priority to projects supporting Hospital.
 - Acquisition planned on 7 of 12 projects beginning in FY08.
